

Kindergarten Enrollment Guide



Kindergarten enrollment opens on the **first Monday** in **March** Children entering kindergarten in the fall must be **5** years old by midnight **August 31**

Enrollment Options

- 1. Online an easy and fast process www.everettsd.org/kindergartenenrollment
 - o **New Everett Public Schools (EPS) Family**: Create an account, complete your child's online enrollment for kindergarten, available in various languages, and upload the required documentation. Review the high-level <u>enrollment instructions</u> or watch the Enrollment Video a Step-By-Step Walkthrough for new families.



o **Family with Student Currently Enrolled in EPS**: Log into your account on <u>Home Access Center</u> (HAC) and enroll your kindergartner. Review the high-level enrollment instructions or watch the Enrollment Video.



2. Paper Enrollment Packet

Print the Enrollment Packet, (Kindergarten) complete it, and deliver to your home school with the required documentation. (Full Kindergarten Enrollment Packet)

Required Documentation (for either option)

- Proof of your child's age A birth certificate, a passport, an adoption record, a hospital certificate, or any other document permitted by law.
 Birth certificates: for children born in Washington State, visit Snohomish County Health District / <u>Birth Certificates</u>, for all other states, visit <u>www.vitalchek.com</u>.
- o **Current proof of address** A recent utility bill, rental agreement, or homeowner's insurance policy that shows the parent/guardian's name and address.
- o **Medically verified immunization records** Contact your child's physician or the Snohomish County Health District / <u>Immunizations</u> at 425-339-5200.
- If applicable health plan, Student Housing Questionnaire (if you do not own/rent your own home), proof of guardianship, parenting plan, or court order that your school staff need to be aware of.

EPS Choice Programs

- o <u>Dual Language Spanish Immersion Program</u> housed at Emerson Elementary School Dual Language Education consistently uses two languages for content instruction, learning and communication - submit your <u>Interest Form</u>
- o <u>Port Gardner Parent Partnership</u> a K-12 choice school, housed at Sequoia High School, where parents partner with certificated staff in teaching their children both at home and onsite submit your <u>Interest Form</u>
- o <u>The Lighthouse Elementary Cooperative</u> housed at Jefferson Elementary School, this K-5 program features standard district curriculum with an overlay of parent involvement via weekly classroom volunteering and support for enrichment activities such as field trips and parent-led specialty lessons.

Important: Space in these programs is limited. Early enrollment is recommended. Contact the school directly for information / assistance.
