

FAMILY HOUSING RESOURCES IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY

NORTH SOUND 211 – Call 211 or go to search.wa211.org -

- If you are sleeping in a car, tent or another place not meant for human habitation, or if you are staying in a motel paid for by a charitable agency, call 211 and ask for a Coordinated Entry intake
- Coordinated Entry Navigators may be available at Carnegie Resource Center; call 425-434-4680 to confirm
- If you are under 30% median income and are losing housing in 14 days or less, call 211 and ask to be connected with a Prevention Coordinator
- If you are ages 18-24, call Cocoon House at 425-426-5002 to be connected with a housing navigator
