My certification is up in June, what do I do?

- *Once you enrolled in this course you qualify to request an extension. Go to the OSPI - Below is from Western's Program FAQs*

Candidates have five years, from the time they complete two consecutive years of certificated employment and accept a contract for a third year with a public school or state-approved private school, to earn the Professional Certificate. Candidates who have not completed these requirements and hold a Residency Certificate with an expiration date should apply to OSPI for a reissued Residency Certificate.
