Everett Public Schools launches Parent University

Giving on-demand access to resources for supporting students in remote learning



On Sept. 2, Everett Public Schools will be launching Parent University. Families will be able to access, at their leisure, important resources online or via mobile to help support their student's remote learning and become full partners in their child's education.

The goals of Parent University are to increase collaboration and involvement between schools, families and community; to educate, empower and connect families with resources that build parent and student confidence, enhance character development and promote life skills to increase likelihood of

family success in academic endeavors.

Parent University will help parents learn how to log in to the online learning platform that will be used across the district, find remote learning schedules, how grading and attendance will be handled, about special services for students, how to access meals during remote learning, about Social Emotional support resources, step-by-step "how to" resources and more. Videos are also available subtitled in the top five languages for our EL families.
