

Middle School Courses for High School Credit

Everett Public Schools students may receive high school credit for specific middle school courses, per Board Procedure 2410.

For students in the graduating class of 2024 and beyond, high school credit bearing courses taken in middle school will automatically be added to the student's transcript, unless requested otherwise by the student and the student's family. Once the middle school course has been removed, it cannot be added back to the transcript. Students and their families can request eligible courses to be removed from their high school transcript any time up through high school graduation.

For students in graduating classes prior to 2024, credits earned while the student was in middle school will be included on the high school transcript upon request of the student and the student's family. Once the middle school course has been added, it cannot be removed from the transcript. Students and their families can request eligible courses to be added to their high school transcript any time up through high school graduation.

Please contact your school registrar for the necessary paperwork to remove or add middle school credits to high school transcripts.

- **11. Washington State History** * All students who pass Washington State History (WSH) in middle school earn a "MET" status on their high school transcript. This is an automatic process that takes place when a student successfully completes the course.
