
## Relative to the State






Percent Proficient Smarter Balanced Assessment English Language Arts: 2019, 2021, and 2022 Everett




## English Language Arts Trend



## English Language Arts Cohort Trend








## English Language Arts Cohort Trend




Percent Proficient Smarter Balanced Assessment Mathematics: 2019, 2021, and 2022 Everett






Percent Proficient Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science Science: 2019, 2021, and 2022 Everett




## Smarter Balanced Assessment Mathematics Grade 4




