Hello,

Our records indicate that your student is currently enrolled in Everett Public Schools on a nonresident student choice transfer. This letter is a reminder that nonresident students who would like to continue their enrollment in Everett Public Schools for the 2023-24 school year must renew their choice transfer request by April 14, 2023. Information regarding nonresident choice transfer requests can be found in Procedure 3141P available on the district's website at <https://www.everettsd.org/Page/24146>. Your family must first apply for a choice transfer release from the school district in which you reside. Please visit your school district's office or website to submit a choice transfer release request. The request will be sent electronically by your school district to Everett Public Schools.

For students of a district employee, choice transfer requests may be submitted beginning February 15. All other choice transfer requests may be submitted beginning March 1. It is important to note that nonresident students are not guaranteed a transfer request approval for the next school year. Not submitting a choice transfer request by April 14 will result in your student being withdrawn from enrollment in Everett Public Schools for the 2023-24 school year.

Eligibility for a choice transfer will be reviewed and evaluated annually using the following criteria:

- a. Whether the student is a child of a district employee subject to RCW 28A.225.225.
- b. The capacity of the building as determined by the district at the building in which the student desires to be enrolled. Schools that are designated by the district as "closed to transfers" do not have available space by definition. Schools that are closed to transfers will be posted on the district's website.
- c. The capacity of the program, grade level and/or classroom as determined by the district at the building in which the student desires to be enrolled.
- d. The availability of a program at a school to meet the educational needs of the student.
- e. Whether approval would result in the district experiencing a financial hardship.
- f. Whether the student's disciplinary records indicate a history of convictions for offenses or crimes, violent or disruptive behavior, or gang membership.
- g. Whether the student has been expelled or suspended from a public school for more than ten (10) consecutive days.
