Title	Joy of Reading
Parent Information	Reading aloud and exploring literature together is an important part of building early literacy skills. Developing print concepts, understanding story elements, learning vocabulary, and building background knowledge are just a few skills that can come from reading with your child. Listening to and talking about the books you read together also supports social emotional learning. Choose books with your child and let their interests guide your selections. Try creating a reading time routine with your child.
	The first grade is year filled with amazing literacy growth. Children are becoming more independent with their reading skills and are eager to read a variety of text. There are many wonderful decodable texts and "chapter book" series that are geared for younger audiences. As children become more fluent with their reading, they can become the "reader" during the reading time routine.
Objective	Read, share, and enjoy books together
Time	15 -20 minutes daily
Materials	Variety of books – fiction and non-fiction
Procedures	<ul> <li>Set aside a time each day to read with your child.</li> <li>Have your child choose a book to read. Preview the text for vocabulary, story elements, or concepts that might be interesting or challenging so you can support as needed.</li> <li>Decide who will be the "reader" or take turns reading the text.</li> <li>Introduce the title, author, and illustrator if applicable.</li> <li>Read the text and support your child by monitoring, providing feedback, and having conversations about the more complex story plots or informational concepts.</li> <li>After reading, talk about the book and ask questions to check for understanding.</li> <li>For longer texts, break the reading time up by chapters or natural stopping points.</li> <li>Once you have shared the text together, encourage your child to reread the text independently.</li> </ul>
