
Teacher Website Tutorial

Your teacher website has been created and you can access it by signing into the Everett Public Schools district website.

- 1. Click on Sign in
- 2. Login using your district credentials.



Enter your user name and password to sign in.




3. Once logged in, click on the User options on the top right and choose Site Manager




If you face issue logging in or if you are not able to see the 'Site Manager' option, please reach out to DMoton@everettsd.org

4. Once in Site Manager, you will see the default pages that are created for you. Edit the pages as needed.

To edit the Welcome Page, click on the Welcome page, this opens the site editor.




5. Click on the green pencil icon on the main content app in order to edit the introduction page




6. The default EPS logo can be replaced with your picture if needed and the text can be modified to content related to you.


To edit the image, you can right click on the EPS logo, and that provides the option 'Image'.




Choose the 3rd option Upload, to upload your photo.




You can adjust the width and height of the image by dragging the image around its corners, or by changing the dimensions in the General tab, Width and height areas as in picture below.



7. In order to add Quicklinks to your page, click on the edit pencil icon on the Quicklinks app,



8. Click on the New Link button to create a new link and fill in the title, the web address/URL where the link needs to redirect to and click Save
