

Basis for increase in appropriation

- Thank you to voters for support and passage of the 2022 capital levy
- 2021-22 capital budget did not include capacity for projects in the 2022 capital levy
- Scope and accelerated timeline for technology deployments






Basis for increase – 2022 capital levy projects

Voters approved a \$325.5 million capital levy in February 2022, which allows the district to begin the following projects:

- \$2.0 million Jackson Elementary School design and pre-construction services
- \$300,000 Security fencing at Cascade and Everett High Schools design and construction
- \$500,000 HM Jackson High School Clean Buildings Act design





Basis for increase – 2016 capital levy project

\$1.2 million - upgrade the district's security camera system



Total increase in appropriation requested – \$4 million
