Samsung Solve for Tomorrow

Samsung Solve for Tomorrow contest is now open. Application submissions will close on **November 2.** You **do not need to be a STEM educator to apply**. Any teacher can apply and <u>win big!</u> Don't just take our word for it; here is a note from a National Winner, Allie. Her team brought home **over \$100,000** in technology and classroom supplies for her school, and she wants to tell you about her journey with SFT, as a PE teacher:

"My name is Allie Langwald, I am a Physical Education teacher from Hope of Detroit Academy in Michigan and I was a Samsung Solve for Tomorrow National Winner. When I first heard about the competition, I thought "will they even let me apply as a PE teacher?" but after reading the rules I realized any teacher can apply. The application seemed intimidating, but once my students settled on the problem they wanted to tackle, the rest fell into place naturally.

My one piece of advice to anyone considering applying, is to just take this chance. You never know until you try and I am so glad that I did! Being part of this competition not only made me a better person, but it also made me a better teacher. My students are so much more passionate about their community and giving back, I have noticed a marked improvement in their engagement in class as well. Now I teach a 7th hour STEM class and decided to make the curriculum focused on projects that solve real world problems in our school community. Students were so excited, there was a waiting list to join the class!"

There are days left to apply, but that's okay. At this point in the contest, you do not need a perfected idea or complete solution. Simply identify the problem you and your students face in the community, which you would like to solve using STEM subjects, and the steps you will take to get there.

Equipment Training

Before new equipment is deployed to your class, CTE staff will be trained on safety, operation, and basic troubleshooting of the equipment. This training often occurs online through the vendor. CTE will also offer in person, one on one training as well.

The goal? To ensure teachers have the necessary skills to safely teach students industry knowledge and skills. Training logs will be provided by your CTE Facilitator during the deployment process.
