Online Classes Registration

Registration for Online High School Summer Academy classes is available through the [Everett Public Schools website](https://www.everettsd.org).

Online High School Summer Academy courses are 100% asynchronous learning. Students do not have a set schedule to work, but may complete course work at any time, though they are expected to log in and make progress daily. All course work and lessons are provided in Canvas. Students can ask questions and meet with teachers, as needed.

Out-Of-District Students

Students living within the Everett Public Schools district boundary who do not attend Everett Public Schools or students who are living outside the Everett Public Schools district who wish to enroll in an Online High School Summer Academy class must register their student with the district prior to enrolling for a summer class.

Payment Information

All students who register for a class are required to pay in full prior to June 10, 2024. Payment instructions will be provided once you have completed registration.

Enrollment

Enrollment is based on the date of registration. It is also based on availability. Many classes fill up early so registering early is advised. Once a class meets its enrollment cap, students will be placed on a waiting list. If students cannot continue with the class, waitlisted students will be asked to join, based on the order of enrollment.

ALL students in a class that is cancelled due to low enrollment or who withdraw from a course prior to July 1, 2024 will receive a full refund. Contact the High School Summer Academy office at 425-385-5170 or hsummer@everettsd.org for refund information.

Students may take only one online class (one semester) at a time during the summer. PE 1 or College and Career Readiness Seminar are the only classes that can be taken concurrently with one other class.

To be eligible to enroll in a second summer school online class you must earn a passing grade in the first class prior to Friday, July 12. This allows time to complete the second course before the end of the summer term on August 1.

Student Responsibilities and Rights Handbook

All Everett Public Schools rules are in effect during the summer program. The Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook can be viewed on the website at www.everettsd.org.

Attendance

Attendance is necessary for learning the content to ensure completion of course requirements. Credit recovery classes during the summer are an opportunity for your student to receive additional help in mastering course content. Failure to attend classes could negatively affect your student's success. Students with three (3) absences may receive NO credit for the course in which they are enrolled. Absences include time accumulated for tardiness, early departure, and disciplinary reasons unless prior arrangements have been made with the teacher.

Please Note

Credit recovery classes are designed to provide the student with an opportunity to learn content not picked up during the regular school year. Once the student has completed the required course work and demonstrated proficiency in the subject, they will be granted a passing grade of "S." If this occurs before the end of the scheduled summer session, they will no longer be required to attend summer classes but could take another credit recovery class, if time allows.
