

The Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST) are the Nation's highest honors for K-12 STEM educators. PAEMST is pleased to announce that the 2024-2025 nomination and application cycle for 7-12th grade teachers is now open.

PAEMST are the highest honors bestowed by the United States government specifically for K-12 science, mathematics, engineering, and technology teaching. The Awards were established by Congress in 1983, and The President may recognize up to 110 exemplary teachers each year. The PAEMST program is administered by the National Science Foundation (NSF) on behalf of the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP).

Each PAEMST awardee receives a \$10,000 award, a commemorative Presidential certificate, and joins a cadre of over 5,200 PAEMST alumni. Awardees are also invited to an awards ceremony in Washington, D.C., and to participate in meetings with STEM education, research, and policy leaders.
