

EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2
RESOLUTION NO. 537

A Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Everett School District No. 2 establishing its opposition to the siting of a Regional Airport at the Proposed Bothell/Mill Creek Site.

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Regional Council has identified a location in the Southern portion of the Everett School District as a tentative site for a regional airport; and

WHEREAS, the Everett School District has recently built two Elementary Schools within the 65 Ldn contour of the current proposal site (considered as the minimum land acquisition required for the project due to significant noise impacts), including:

WHEREAS, the Everett School District owns and operates a number of other schools in the general vicinity of the current proposal site, including:

WHEREAS, the Everett School District has purchased property in the general vicinity of the current proposal site for future school projects, including 13.9 acres at 4117 - 132nd Street SE and approximately 15 acres adjacent to Gateway Middle School; and


WHEREAS, anticipated population increases will require construction of additional school facilities at all grade levels; and

WHEREAS, the siting of a regional airport in this area would adversely impact existing and future school sites and disrupt or detrimentally affect the District's ability to provide a quality education to its students, hindering the effective, efficient and safe management and operation of the District.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2 opposes the siting of a regional airport at the proposed Bothell/Mill Creek Site ,

AND FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent or her designee, be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to monitor and participate in discussions concerning the regional airport and to provide information that may assist in development of a proposal that will not adversely affect public education in the District.


