- e. Commitment to provide to the OSPI the executed contract with the energy services company for the work to be done under this grant;
- f. Commitment to provide the OSPI the following two standard reports from the Energy Services Company:
 - 1. The "Notice of Commencement of Energy Savings" immediately after project completion, and;
 - 2. The "Monitoring and Verification Report" one year from the date of project completion.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of Everett Public Schools intends to comply with all OSPI requirements as set forth above.
