WHEREAS, the Everett School District Board of Directors recognizes school employees who have retired from active teaching, administration, or a specialized field of the teaching profession; and


WHEREAS, school retirees aid in advancing education by supporting high educational standards, thereby strengthening the status of the teaching profession; and

WHEREAS, school retirees promote group and individual involvement in charitable projects and activities, sponsor scholarships, and maintain interest and participate in educational and community activities; and


WHEREAS, school retirees encourage one another to remain active in the education profession through volunteer activities associated with learning;
