## **INSTRUCTION**

## Health, Family Life, AIDS, and Sex Education

Health, family life, AIDS, and sex education, including information about human anatomy, reproduction and related topics, shall be included in the instructional program as appropriate to the grade level and course of study. The instructional approach shall be developed after consultation with parents/guardians and appropriate community representatives.

The life-threatening dangers of Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and its prevention will be taught to students in grade 5 through grade 12. AIDS prevention education shall be limited to the discussion of the life-threatening dangers of the disease, its spread, and prevention.
