We currently have **over 600 students** who are enrolled in Everett Public Schools and are qualified as a “**Kid in Transition**” (KIT). This means they are either unsheltered (they don't know where they will sleep tonight), doubled-up with another family, in a temporary shelter, living in a car, or in another unstable home situation.

The holidays and cold winter months can be particularly rough on these students and their families. In the past, we have had generous donations during the holiday season to help our KIT families and unaccompanied youth.
