RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. By adding as many as 15 team spots for middle school girls, the percentage of females participating in athletics would increase by 2% and the percentage of males participating in athletics would decrease by 2%. This could be accomplished by adding a third volleyball coach at each middle school, thus providing more opportunity for females to participate in volleyball. The approximate cost of this addition will be \$13,000, depending on the experience of the coach. There would be no additional transportation costs.
- 2. Continue to support a girls soccer "C-Team" at each high school. Presently only Jackson High School offers a girls C-team. Adding a C-team at Cascade and Everett will lead to more girls participating in a sport.
- 3. In 2014-15 each high school saw a dramatic increase in the number of students trying out for boys soccer. Many of these students come from immigrant families where English is not their first language. Adding a C-team for boys soccer at each high school may lead to an increase in participation and school engagement for ELL students and their families.
- 4. In order to add opportunities of interest for females and ELL students in general, it is recommended that middle school boys and girls soccer be added as a WIAA sponsored sport. Adding girls soccer will increase the number of girls involved in athletics. Adding boys soccer will offer a sport traditionally enjoyed by boys from diverse backgrounds.
