

Wingfield, there is an estimated need for urgent school projects for the winter construction and equipment of new school buildings and sufficient to meet the requirements of the acquisition of additional buildings, either ordinary or permanent, improvements and renovations and expenditures, both ordinary and extraordinary, necessary to provide additional funds for winter school purposes, and

whereas, Plans have heretofore been made for the acquisition of site for new high construction and equipment of a new school building and to meet the needs of the buildings and for the proposed improvements, modernization and enlargement of existing school buildings, mobiles and buildings will

therefore, by reason of increased costs, money sufficient to carry out such plans are not available, and the estimated cost of said additional buildings and equipment is hereby declared to be, in addition to funds otherwise available for such purpose, the sum of two hundred fifty seven thousand five hundred and 50/100 (\$257,054.50) Dollars, and the estimated cost of the proposed improvements, modernization and enlargement of existing school buildings, facilities and equipment, in addition to funds otherwise available for such purposes, is determined to be the sum of two hundred fifty seven thousand fifty seven and 50/100 (\$257,054.50) Dollars,

which amount by the Board of Directors of Wingfield District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington, shall said amount shall fund be raised as follows:

The first \$25,000.00 by the Levy in the State Tax of a tax of 10 mills, which amount is to pay down first to the amount provided by law, for

the purpose of maintenance, repairs, improvements, modernization, enlargement and renovations of existing school buildings, facilities and equipment.

On ~~\$257,056.50~~ by the levy for the year 1940 or a tax of 10 mills without regard to any tax limitations provided by law for the purpose of maintaining said levy and the other structures which will provide for new school buildings.

By and further be it enacted that an emergency election shall be held at Everett High School District No. 8 of Snohomish County, Washington on the 2d day of November, 1940 at which time shall be submitted to the qualified voters of said district the following propositions:

Proposed:

1. Whether or not Everett School District No. 8 of Snohomish County, Washington, shall be authorized to levy in the year 1940 a tax of 10 mills without regard to any tax limitation provided by law, to secure funds in the estimated amount of ~~\$257,056.50~~ for the purpose of maintaining, repairing, repairing, modernizing and rehabilitating existing school buildings, facilities and equipment in addition to funds otherwise available for said purpose.

2. Whether or not Everett School District No. 8 of Snohomish County, Washington, shall be authorized to levy in the year 1940 a tax of 10 mills, without regard to any tax limitation provided by law, to secure funds in the estimated amount of ~~\$257,056.50~~, for the acquisition of a plot of land for, and the construction of new buildings and equipment, in addition to funds otherwise available for said purpose.

It is further resolved that the County Auditor of Snohomish County, Washington, be and his or her office requested to provide places in each precinct school district no. 8 of Snohomish County, Washington for holding such elections, to appoint two election officials, namely, for each election, one ballot box, poll books and tally sheets, and sufficient ballot boxes for the precincts, and to furnish said posts, election officials and their polling places, and to publish said post-
