

RESOLUTION NO. 16

WHEREAS, there is an existing need in Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, for the acquisition of additional sites for, and the construction and equipment of, new school buildings sufficient to meet the requirements of the District, and

WHEREAS, many of the existing school buildings and equipment therein, need extensive repairs, improvements and rehabilitating, and

WHEREAS, the funds available for such purposes are hopelessly inadequate and it is therefore necessary to provide additional funds for such school purposes, and

WHEREAS, plans have heretofore been made for the acquisition of sites for, and the construction and equipment of, new school buildings to meet the needs of the District and for the repair, improvement, modernization and rehabilitation of existing school buildings, school facilities and equipment, and

WHEREAS, by reason of increased costs, monies sufficient to carry out such said plans are not available, and the estimated cost of said additional sites, buildings and equipment is hereby declared to be, in addition to funds otherwise available for such purpose, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand Fifty Four and 39/100 (\$257,054.39) Dollars, and the estimated cost of the repairs, improvement, modernization and rehabilitation of existing school buildings, facilities and equipment, in addition to funds otherwise available for such purpose, is declared to be the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand Fifty Four and 39/100 (\$257,054.39) Dollars, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED: by the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington, that said additional funds be raised as follows:

1. \$257,054.39 by the levy in the year 1949 of a tax of 10 mills, without regard to any tax limitations provided by law, for

the purpose of maintenance, repair, improvement, modernization and rehabilitation of existing school buildings, facilities and equipment.

2. \$257,054.39 by the levy in the year 1940 of a tax of 10 mills, without regard to any tax limitations provided by law, for the purpose of acquiring sites for, and the construction and equipment of new school buildings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That an emergency exists requiring a special election, whereas the voters within said Everett School District No. 2 may ratify or reject the two propositions herein mentioned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a special election shall be held in Everett School District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington on the 24 day of November, 1940, at which there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of said District the following propositions, to-wit:

1. Whether or not Everett School District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington, shall be authorized to levy in the year 1940 a tax of 10 mills, without regard to any tax limitations provided by law, to secure funds in the estimated amount of \$257,054.39 for the purpose of maintaining, improving, repairing, modernizing and rehabilitating existing school buildings, facilities and equipment, in addition to funds otherwise available for said purpose.

2. Whether or not Everett School District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington, shall be authorized to levy in the year 1940 a tax of 10 mills, without regard to any tax limitations provided by law, to secure funds in the estimated amount of \$257,054.39, for the acquiring of sites for, and the construction of new buildings and equipping same, in addition to funds otherwise available for said purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the County Auditor of Snohomish County, Washington be, and he is hereby requested to provide places in said Everett School District No. 2, of Snohomish County, Washington for holding such elections; to appoint the election officers thereof to provide for their compensation; to provide ballots, poll books, and tally sheets therefor; and deliver them to the Precinct Election Officers at the polling places; and to publish and post

notice of said election in the manner provided by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the propositions submitted by this Resolution shall appear upon the ballot in substantially the following form:

PROPOSITION NO. I

Shall Everett School District No. 2 be authorized to levy in the year 1948, a tax of 10 mills, without regard to any tax limitations provided by law, for the purpose of maintenance, repairs, improvement, modernization and rehabilitation of existing school buildings, facilities and equipment.
