## RESOLUTION NO. 62

WHEREAS, there is an existing need in Everett School Dis-
trict No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, for the acquisition of
additional sites for, and the construction and equipment of new
school buildings, additions to existing buildings, particularly
the GARFIELD, HAWTHORNE, JACKSON, LONGFELLOW, LOWELL, MONROE,
NORTH JUNIOR, SILVER LAKE, SOUTH JUNIOR, VIEW RIDGE, WASHINGTON
and EVERETT HIGH SCHOOL and WHITTIER,/and equipment for same, sufficient to meet the re-
quirements of the District, and

WHEREAS, the funds available for such purposes are hopelessly inadequate and it is necessary to provide additional funds for such school purposes, and

WHEREAS, plans have heretofore been made for the acquisition of sites for, and the construction and equipment of new school buildings, particularly two new grade schools, new Junior High school and new Junior College, and additions to existing buildings, to partially meet the needs of the District, including additional facilities at the Stadium, and new administration facilities, and

WHEREAS, such new school buildings and additions to present buildings are necessary to meet the needs of the District, together with suitable sites for same, and

WHEREAS, by reason of increased costs, monies sufficient to carry out such plans are not available, and the estimated cost of said additional sites, buildings, additions and equipment is hereby declared to be, in addition to funds otherwise available for such purposes, the sum of <a href="https://doi.org/>

(\$3,750,000.00 ) Dollars;

## NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED: By the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington, that said additional funds be raised as follows:

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(\$ 3.750,000.00 ) Dollars by the incurring of a general indebtedness in said sum and the issuance of general negotiable serial coupon bonds for said sum which shall be in denominations of \$1,000.00 each, to be numbered from one (1) to Three Thousand Seven Hundred-(3.750), inclusive, and shall bear interest payable semi-annually at not to exceed 6% per annum. The various annual maturities of said bonds, commencing with the second year after date of issuance and ending twenty (20) years after date shall, as near as practicable, be in such amounts as will, together with the interest on all outstanding bonds, be met by an equal annual levy, without regard to any tax limitations provided by law, for the payment of said bonds and interest. Said District reserves the right to redeem any or all of said bonds in inverse numerical order on any interest paying date on and a fter five (5) years from the date of issue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That an emergency exists, requiring a special election, whereat the voters within said Everett School District No. 2 may ratify or reject the proposition herein mentioned.

BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a special election shall be held in Everett School District No. 2 of Snohomish County, Washington, on the 8th day of November, 1955, at which election there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of said District the following proposition, to-wit:

1. Shall Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, issue its general obligation negotiable serial coupon bonds in the principal sum of Three Million Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand

(\$3,750,000.00

Dollars, or so much thereof as may be permitted by the laws governing the limitation of indebtedness of school districts, such bonds to be sold at such time or times as permitted by law, to be

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paid by annual tax levies, without limitation as to rate or amount, to bear interest at a rate not to exceed 6% per annum, and to mature from two to twenty years from date of issue, the district to reserve the right to redeem any or all of said bonds in inverse numerical order on any interest paying date on and after five years from the date of issue. The money received from the sale of said bonds to be used for the purpose of acquiring sites for school buildings, making additions to existing buildings, building new school buildings and equipping same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Clerk of the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, be and he is hereby directed to provide ballots, poll books and tally sheets, to provide polling places and deliver ballots, poll books and tally sheets to the Precinct Election Officers at the polling places; to publish and post notices of said election in the manner and for the time required by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the polling places be open from 8:00 A. M. to 8:00 P. M.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the said District Clerk cooperate in every way with the Supervisor of Elections for Snohomish County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the proposition submitted by this Resolution shall appear upon the ballot in substantially the following form:

Shall Everett School District issue

Three Million Seven Hundred and Fifty
Thousand (\$ 3,750,000.00

Dollars of bonds, to be paid out of annual tax levies, without regard to tax limitations provided by law, for school sites, schools, additions to existing schools, and equipment for same.
