## The Story (what will you say)

- (B) Focus on character and setting
  - Late at night
  - Moon shining, stars twinkling in the sky
  - Sleeping soundly, snoring away
- (M) Focus on significant event and speech bubble
  - Startled by a noise
  - Jumped and ran to the window
  - Wanted to see what made the loud sound ("What was that?")

#### (E) – Focus on emotion

- Couldn't believe my eyes
- Two owls (hooting, chatting) back and forth

The Sentences (What are the key sentence you will write?)

Startled out of my deep sleep, I jumped up to look out at the dark night sky.

Two owls were busy chatting back and forth in my tree.
