Glossary for Post-Secondary Terms

Certificate of Completion — Awarded in many technical and career fields and designed to prepare graduates for employment. Typically programs are one year in length and can lead to an associate degree.

Associate Degree — A two-year college degree awarded at a community or technical college upon completion of coursework (i.e. Associate of Arts; Associate of Science).

Bachelor Degree — A four-year college degree at a university, college, also offered at some two-year colleges. Awarded upon completion of all coursework. (i.e. Bachelor of Arts; Bachelor of Science).

Glossary for Post-Secondary Terms

Open Admission — An admission policy that accepts students without regard to the criteria of grade point average and/or test scores.

Regular Admission — The application process that requires application materials to be submitted no later than the specified deadline. Admission responses are usually received in March.

Early Action — An admission plan used primarily in highly selective colleges. Under Early Action, you follow an accelerated application process and usually apply by November 1. You will be notified of a decision by mid-December, but, if you are accepted, you do not have to let the institution know of your decision until May 1.

Early Decision — An admission plan well-qualified applicants who are definitely committed to their choice of college. Applicants will be notified of their acceptance or refusal in December. Acceptance under Early Decision requires you to withdraw applications at other colleges.

FINDING THE RIGHT FIT

Post-Secondary College & University Options

Public Colleges	Private Colleges
- Funded by local and state governments - Usually offer lower tuition rates than private colleges for in-state residents 	- Funded primarily by tuition, fees, and other private sources - Private donations can fund generous financial aid packages for students 
Liberal Arts Colleges & Universities	For Profit Colleges
- Offer a broad base of courses in liberal arts - Literature, history, languages, math, life sciences - Most are private offering four-year programs 	- Businesses that offer a variety of degree programs - Typically prepare you for specific career - Tend to have higher costs and not all credits transfer 
Special Focus Colleges	Specialized Mission Colleges
Focused on a specific interest or student population 	- HBCUs – Historically black colleges and universities - HSIs – Hispanic-serving institutions - Offer programs, services and activities targeted toward underrepresented students
