Authorization of Facsimile Signature

WHEREAS, Chapter 86, Laws of 1969, as codified in RCW 39.62, authorizes the use of facsimile signatures by any public officer in lieu of a manual signature to execute any "public security" or any "instrument of payment"; and


WHEREAS, the statute further requires that before any authorized officer may use a facsimile signature plate or stamp, he or she must file a manual signature with the Secretary of State, duly certified while under oath; and

WHEREAS, Ian B. Saltzman, Superintendent and Secretary of the Board, will file a Certificate of Manual Signature, duly certified under oath, with the Auditor of Snohomish County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the facsimile plate or stamp, as imprinted below, for Ian B. Saltzman, Superintendent and Secretary of the Board, be accepted for use in lieu of a manual signature on any public security or any instrument of pay of Everett School District No. 2 effective July 1, 2019.


