#### What is School-wide PBIS?

#### School-wide PBIS is:

 A systems approach, establishing the social culture and behavioral supports needed for schools to be effective learning environments for all students.

#### Evidence-based features of SW-PBIS

- Prevention
- Define and teach positive social expectations
- Dehavioral Intervention Support

- Acknowledge positive behavior
- Arrange consistent consequences for problem behavior
- Collection and use of data for decision-making
- Continuum of intensive, individual interventions.
- Administrative leadership Team-based implementation

### Why implement SWPBIS?

#### Create a positive school culture:

#### School environment is <u>predictable</u>

- 1. common language
- 2. common vision (understanding of expectations)
- 3. common experience (everyone knows)

#### School environment is positive


regular recognition for positive behavior

#### School environment is safe

violent and disruptive behavior is not tolerated

#### School environment is consistent

adults use similar expectations.
