- On the top middle of the page highlight "For Students," then click on "Online Grades."
- Please enter your username and password (Same as logging onto the internet: Username = ID # and Password = mm-dd).
 - 1. Click on "Attendance" have you missed any days?
 - 2. Click on "Behavior Incidents" how is your behavior?
 - 3. Click on "Progress Reports." All A's and B's? Are you missing any assignments?
 - 4. Click on "Transcript" how were your grades last year?
 - 5. Click on "Assessments" did you meet standard on the WASL?

Down Loading Your Middle School Course Map

- Go to the XXXXX Middle School home page
- Click on "XXXXXXXX"
- Click on "Course Map"
- Click "Open"
- Go to the top left of the screen and click "File" then "Save As."
- Save the Course Map to the computer's desktop saving it as "<u>First Name_Last</u> <u>Name_CourseMap</u>"
 - Example: Joe_Smith_CourseMap

Filling in Course Map

- Click on "Transcript" fill in your 6th grade section of the course map
- Click on "Assessments" fill in your 6th grade WASL scores
- When you have filled in the 6th grade section save what you have done.

Reading, Math and Science WASL Scores

- Scores <u>below</u> standard
 - \circ Level 1 = 1 to 374
 - Level 2 = 375 to 399

Scores at **standard** or **above**

- \circ Level 3 = 400 to 425 +/-
- Level 4 = 425 +/- and higher

Writing WASL Scores

- Scores <u>below</u> standard
 - Level 1 = 1 to 6
 - Level 2 = 7 to 8
- Scores at <u>standard</u> or <u>above</u>
 - Level 3 = 9 to 10
 - Level 4 = 11 to 12

- Go to www.bridges.com
- Click on "<u>Site ID</u>" in the upper right of the page
 - Enter Site ID: XXXXXXX
 - Enter Password: XXXXXXX
- Click on "<u>Choices Explorer</u>" in the middle of the page
- Click on "<u>Sign in</u>" just below the Search field in the top right of the screen

Logging into www.Bridges.com

- <u>IF</u> you logged in last year enter your Portfolio Name and Password
- IF you did not Click on "Create a portfolio"
- Fill in information
 - Make "Portfolio Name" the first initial of your first name, last name followed by the year you were born (For example: jschilaty76)
 - Make "<u>Portfolio Password</u>" your birth date (<u>MM-DD</u>)
 - Click on "<u>Create your Portfolio</u>"

- Once you are logged in Click on "<u>Your Portfolio</u>" tab
- Click on "<u>Your Activities</u>"
- Click on "Add a file"
- Click on "Browse"
- Find your Course Map on the Desktop and click it and then Click on "Open"
- Click on "<u>Upload this file and return to Your</u> <u>Activities</u>"
