Modeling with Mathematics: A Bridge to Algebra II text considered for new high school math course

A mathematics course that offers students an exciting new perspective on mathematics, *Modeling With Mathematics* develops algebra concepts through real-life topics such as, business, forensic science, financial literacy and other important real-world examples. Mathematical modeling and a data-driven approach to solving functions helps students deepen their mathematical skills and maturity. *Modeling With Mathematics: A Bridge To Algebra II* has been designed for students who have completed Algebra I or Algebra I and Geometry but need review practice and motivation to succeed in Algebra II. In addition, the course gives students a look ahead to many Algebra II topics.
