

## **Section 1**

The **softball** \*3 is a ball larger than a baseball, but smaller than a grapefruit. It has the same density and look as a baseball. The softball diamond is smaller in dimension than a baseball diamond. In softball the base paths are 60 feet instead of 90 feet. Also, the pitching mound is 40 feet instead of 60 feet.
