Judgment: Yes, it's fair/ No, it's not fair... The captain treated the crew members fairly. Evidence: He is tolerant and gentle with them. He tried to solve their problem and eventually saved them. He helped them to get passage home at the end.

I disagree with the crew's reasoning when they continued to watch the stone. Evidence: The stone overtook their lives. They became ape-like and mutinous. Opinion: I agree/disagree... I disagree with the Captain's reasoning. Evidence: He was not strong enough to keep the crew away from the stone and doing their duties. This led to mutiny and the destruction of the ship.
