

High School Visual Art Introduction to Art Classroom Based Performance Assessment Assignment Checklist

Students will create an observational portrait of a full face in graphite. Through this assignment, students will demonstrate how to use:

- Value to define form of facial features.
- Form to create depth of facial features.
- Value to accurately replicate shadow and light.
- Shape.
- Proportion and placement.
- Line and Edge.
- Texture.
- Space to create a face that occupies at least one-half of the paper.

In order to complete this assignment, students may:

- Use a photograph (recommended black and white, head and shoulders, approximately 8x11).
- Use a grid.

The final size of this observational drawing is approximately 9x12.
