

Education pays in higher earnings and lower unemployment rates



What is the FAFSA?

FAFSA stands for Free Application for Fe deral Student Aid. It is the application that all college students must complete if they wish to get lows or grants to pay for college.

The United States Department of Education creates the FAFSA and manages the student lows and grants that are given to college students. There are three main types of student aid. Grants—which do not have to be paid back. Loans—which do have to be paid back with interest. And Work-Study—which

Students planning to attend college the year after they graduate from high se hool should fill out the FAFSA in January of their sendor year. It is available online starting January Ist

Who Should Fill Out the FAFS A?

Anyone planning to attend a post-secon dary institution should fill out the FAFSA. This indudes:

- 4 year Universities
- Community Colleges
- Private Trade & Technical Schools

Evenifyou do not plan on using loans to pay for college you should fill out the FAFSA because many scholarship ap plications ask for your Expected Family Contribution (EFC). The EFC is generated when you complete the FAFSA.

EFC = Expected Family Contribution
