GHB

- Depressant; **banned by FDA**
- Odorless, colorless liquid
- “Date Rape” drug
- Effect: drowsiness, dizziness, nausea, physically addicting





ROHYPNOL

“Roofies”

- Tasteless, odorless, colorless
- Another “Date Rape” drug
- Effects: drowsiness, disorientation, confusion, impairs mind, short-term amnesia





OXYCONTIN

- Painkiller to treat cancer patients, chronic pain
- Time release system
- Effects: Suppresses the respiratory system, rapidly addictive, can be deadly combined with alcohol, vomiting, mental “cloudiness”




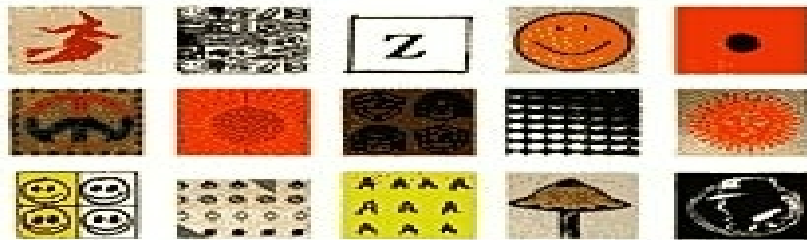
ECSTASY

- MDMA (Methylenedioxymethamphetamine)
- Heightens senses: touch, smell, sight, sounds
- Release large amounts of serotonin (hormone that sends messages)
- Effects: confusion, paranoia, muscle tension, teeth clenching, nausea, rapid eye movement, extreme thirst—hyperthermia



Other dangerous Club Drugs

- Ketamine—animal tranquillizer
 - Numbness, can be fatal when mixed with alcohol
 - LSD—hallucinogens
 - Causes: flashbacks, panic attacks
