## What Changes Come With Parenthood?

- Parenthood begins with having a child by <u>birth</u> or adoption.
- Changes that occur are a change in lifestyle
- New Responsibilities
- Emotional Adjustments
- Changes in <u>Relationships</u>
- Changes at Work

#### Rewards of Parenthood

- Many joys are brought by parenthood
- There is nothing quite like a baby's first smile or hearing a three year old say "I love you".
- Parents are able to <u>see</u> the <u>world</u> differently through their child's eyes as they discover it.
- Raising children can give parents a great sense of <u>accomplishment</u>.

# Making Decisions About Parenthood

- You must have a <u>clear picture</u> of what parenthood is before you decide to become a parent.
- You need to <u>realistically</u> <u>ask</u> yourself if you are ready for parenthood.
- You must have <u>emotional</u> <u>maturity</u> to be able to handle the changes that parenthood brings.

# **Emotional Maturity in Parenthood**

- You must be able to say that you are <u>emotionally secure</u> enough to be able to devote your entire attention to an infant without receiving any attention in return.
- If you have any <u>doubts</u>, it may be best to postpone parenthood.

#### Unsound Reasons for Parenthood

- Our marriage is in <u>trouble</u>. Having a baby will not solve your problems.
- A baby is someone who will love me and belong to me.
- I feel like I'm nobody. Being a parent will make me <u>somebody</u>.
- I want someone who will take <u>care</u> of me when I'm old.
- Our parents <u>want</u> grandchildren

#### Sound Reasons to Become a Parent

- Having children will <u>add depth</u> to our relationship, which is already strong.
- I want to give a baby my <u>care</u> and <u>love</u>.
- I feel good about myself and believe that parenthood will be a <u>rewarding</u> experience.
- I want to experience the <u>special bond</u> between parent and child, which lasts a lifetime.
- I love children, and I want to be a parent.

# Management Skills for Parenting

- Whatever the decision, parents will need good money <u>management skills</u>, as well as managing other resources.
- Set goals
- Identify resources
- Make a plan
- Put the plan in action
- Reevaluate from time to time
