# The Caregiver's Role in Helping Children Learn TEACHER'S KEY

#### Scenario #1

A child brings her dog for show and tell. All of the children are very excited about the dog.

- Examples of meaningful questions:
  - o What does your dog like to do?
  - o How are dogs the same as/different from people? Cats?
  - o How do you take care of a dog?
- Examples of information:
  - All dogs have four legs and are covered with fur.
  - Dogs need to be cared for. They need food and water and exercise.
  - Doctors who care for animals are called veterinarians.
  - There are many different kinds of dogs. Dogs come in many sizes and colors.

#### Scenario #2

It is late September and you have taken the class for a walk to collect leaves.

- Examples of meaningful questions:
  - Why do you think that the leaves are different shapes, colors, and sizes?
  - o When do leaves fall off the trees?
  - O Why do leaves fall off trees?
- Examples of information:
  - Leaves change colors and fall to the ground in fall.
  - There are many different kinds of trees. Each tree has its own shape and size of leaf.
  - Leaves grow on trees every spring.

#### Scenario #3

It is the first snowfall of the year.

- Examples of meaningful questions:
  - O What is the temperature outside when it snows?
  - O What are some of the things we can do in the snow?
  - O What happens to snow when it gets warm?
- Examples of information:
  - All snowflakes are different.
  - o It must be cold outside to snow.
  - Snow melts and changes to water when warm.
  - We wear warm coats, hats, mittens, and boots to go outside in the snow.
