6 new classrooms were proposed to house a student enrollment growing well beyond the school's original capacity, and 7 new classrooms were actually constructed. \$247,491 of the costs for this project were covered by

mitigation/impact fees.

#### 8 Classroom Additions at Jackson HS

Estimated Cost: \$4,055,000 Actual Cost: \$4,431,337 Project Completed: 2005

8 new classrooms were proposed to meet enrollment at Jackson HS that is over the permanent building capacity and projected to grow. 12 classrooms were actually constructed in a two-story addition at the west end of the classroom wing. \$997,445 of the costs for this project were covered by mitigation/impact fees.

## 8 Classroom Additions at Gateway MS

8 new classrooms were constructed to house growing enrollment at Gateway MS. \$931,757 of the costs for this project were covered by mitigation/impact fees.

#### **Eisenhower MS Modernization**

Project Completed: Summer 2006

This school received a full modernization and/or replacement of all building systems including heating, ventilation, electrical, plumbing, roofing, finishes, and the structure was strengthened to better withstand earthquakes. This project focused on the needs of today's society and the future, including flexible spaces, community use and technology. Due to interest revenues from the bond funds, the original scope of this project was able to be substantially increased to provide a building addition and a more complete modernization of other building areas – to better meet the needs of the students and the educational program.

This project expanded these systems to provide after-hours security monitoring for all building areas, and more complete (but still partial) after hour fire alarm monitoring, at the following locations: Garfield ES, Jefferson ES, Monroe ES, Woodside ES, Silver Lake ES, View Ridge ES, Whittier ES, Mill Creek ES, Silver Firs ES, North MS, Everett HS and some administrative sites.

#### **Property Purchases – Central Bus Facility**
