The Administration recommends the Board of Directors authorize a call for bids for the Everett Memorial Stadium baseball field drainage improvements (ATTACHMENT). The estimated construction cost is \$475,000, plus Washington State sales tax, and will

provide a complete replacement for the drainage and irrigation systems in the outfield of the baseball field, including removal and replacement of 12 inches of soil, installation of a new natural grass field surface and other drainage improvements in the infield area. The project will be funded through a \$750,000 allocation for minor league baseball facilities improvements provided to the District by the State of Washington in their 2006 supplemental operating budget. The work is scheduled to be completed prior to the beginning of the Spring 2007 high school baseball practices.
